


## Procedure for Clearing the Web Browser Cache


After upgrading the version, follow the procedure below and clear the cache from your web browser.

### Microsoft Edge:


- ① Click the Microsoft Edge menu button.




- ② Click [Settings].




- ③ Click [Privacy, search, and services].




- ④ Under “Clear browsing data” and “Clear browsing data now,” click [Choose what to clear].




- ⑤ Under “Time range,” select [All time].



⑥ Select only [Cached images and files].




⑦ Click [Clear now].




## Google Chrome:


- ① Click the Google Chrome menu button.




- ② Click [Settings].




③ Click [Privacy and security].




④ Click [Clear browsing data].
